Introduction

As an institution committed to academic excellence and character development, The Springfield Primary School implements a school uniform policy to instill professionalism, discipline, and respect among our students. By wearing the designated uniform, students demonstrate their commitment to our school's values and standards.

General Guidelines

- 1. Complete Uniform: Students must wear the complete school uniform on all days.
- 2. Cleanliness and Ironing: Uniforms should be clean and ironed neatly.
- 3. School ID Card: After receiving their school ID cards, students must wear them every day. Entry to the school will not be permitted without the ID card.

Personal Grooming and Accessories

- 1. Jewelry: Girls are only permitted to wear studs in their ears. No other gold ornaments or fashion accessories are allowed.
- 2. Undergarments: Parents must ensure their child wears clean undergarments.
- 3. Nails: All students must maintain properly cut nails.
- 4. Haircut:
 - Boys: Regular haircut is required.
 - Girls:
 - Long hair: Must be tied into 2 plaits with a black hair band.
 - Short hair: Must be tied/pinned neatly with a black band/tic-tac hair clip.

Additional Requirements

- 1. Extra Set of Clothes: For Grade 1 students, parents must send an extra set of clothes and undergarments for the first few months.
- 2. Sweaters/Jackets: Only sweaters/jackets provided by the school are permitted.

- 3. Leggings: Girls may wear ankle-length white leggings with the regular school uniform.
- 4. House Uniform: Students of all grades must wear House-colored uniforms every Thursday.
- 5. Shoes and Socks:
 - Girls: Black shoes and white socks.
 - Boys: Black shoes and white/Navy Blue socks.
- 6. Belts: Boys may only wear black belts.

Special Dress Code Guidelines for Color Days

On designated color days or special events, students are permitted to wear colorful attire to school. However, the following guidelines must be adhered to:

For Girls:

- 1. Dresses or tops must have sleeves (no sleeveless attire).
- 2. Dresses or skirts must be knee-length or below.
- 3. No revealing or tight-fitting clothing.
- 4. No transparent or see-through fabrics.
- 5. Dressing should be modest and respectful, adhering to Qatar's cultural norms.

For Boys:

- 1. No short pants (pants must be knee-length or below).
- 2. No sleeveless shirts.
- 3. No revealing or tight-fitting clothing.
- 4. No transparent or see-through fabrics.
- 5. Dressing should be modest and respectful, adhering to Qatar's cultural norms.

General Guidelines:

- 1. Clothing should not display inappropriate logos, slogans, or graphics.
- 2. Footwear should be clean, decent, and suitable for school.
- 3. Accessories should be minimal and not distracting.
- 4. Hair should be neatly groomed.

Respect for Qatar's Cultural Norms

We emphasize the importance of respecting Qatar's cultural and social values. Students are expected to dress modestly and avoid attire that may be considered inappropriate or offensive.

Responsibility

Parents and guardians are expected to ensure their child adheres to the school uniform policy. Students who fail to comply with these guidelines may face disciplinary action.
